IMPORTANT INFORMATION

NB1. Financial Statement & Health Insurance Cover

On registration at the University of Limerick, all NON-EU students will be required to individually meet with the Garda National Immigration Bureau in Limerick city centre. Appointments for this meeting are set up by the International Education Division and students must pay a mandatory administration fee to the GNIB at this appointment. Students will need proof of financial ability to support themselves for the duration of their study period.

1. If a student is supporting him/herself financially, they will need to show proof to the GNIB officer that they have sufficient funds in their bank accounts – at least €1,500 per semester.
2. If a parent is supporting the student, the student will need to have a notarised letter of financial support from their parents to bring to their GNIB appointment. If this is not sent with the application form it is the responsibility of the student to ensure they bring it with them.
3. All Non-EU Study Abroad students need to extend their general medical insurance to cover their stay while in Ireland.

NB2. Equine Science Classes/Modules

Students who wish to participate in any of the following Equine Science modules should note that resource and scheduling constraints limit places, therefore, we cannot guarantee enrolment: EQ2001, EQ2101, EQ2002, EQ2003, EQ2102, EQ2103, EQ3006, EQ4001, EQ4002, EQ4003, EQ4004, EQ4007, EQ4008, EQ4017, EQ4018, EQ4026. Available places are allocated to Equine Science majors first and are subject to interview and/or skills assessment. It is unlikely that any student will be able to enrol for more than one of these modules. Students who wish to join one of these modules are also required to enrol for one of the following; EV2001, EV4005, EV3005, EV4013, EV4015, EV4005, EV4017, EV4008, EV4012, EV4014, EV4022.

1. Get as many EQ- modules approved as possible - especially EQ4002 as this is the one most likely of having space in for you.
2. Make and send a short video in .mpeg format on CD or DVD showing you riding over fences, this footage does not need to be very long; perhaps you could get a friend to do this during one of your sessions at home. Please ensure you put your name & college on your CD. It might be possible for you to e-mail this. HOWEVER, IT MUST NOT BE BIGGER THAN 1mb or it will not be delivered. E-mail to: study.abroad@ul.ie.
3. Write a short resume of you equestrian competence and achievements to date. i.e. What you feel confident doing on the flat and jumping, any teaching or riding certification you have and any "on horse" experience. If you have ridden work on racehorses or if you have experience of western riding.
