No more than 9 (nine) hours of credit may be applied to the major from any one full semester abroad (fall or spring) and no more than 6 (six) from a summer study abroad program. Spanish Minors: At least 9 (nine) of the 15 credit hours required for the Spanish minor must be taken at Truman or in a study abroad program directed by a Truman faculty member. Thus, Spanish minors may apply a maximum of 6 (six) hours of coursework from outside the Truman Spanish program (i.e., from study abroad programs not directed by Truman faculty, or from transfer credit).
