PERSHING STIPEND CULTURAL EXPERIENCE APPLICATION

Truman State University is pleased to offer Pershing Scholars the opportunity to participate in one study-abroad program during their attendance at the University. This is an excellent chance to learn about life in another country while earning credit toward a degree.

Truman State University will cover up to \$4,000 toward the cost of the trip. The \$4,000 can include tuition, room, board, books, airfare and other travel expenses incurred in getting to the University. Students are responsible for their own miscellaneous and personal travel expenses. If the covered costs of the study abroad experience exceed the \$4,000 allocated and a student needs additional financial assistance, federal student loan or Truman State University cultural loan options can be discussed with the Financial Aid Office.

To be eligible to participate in the Pershing Scholarship Cultural Experience, a student must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Selected as a recipient of the Pershing Scholarship and currently enrolled at Truman.
- 2. Currently eligible for the Pershing Scholarship.

In addition, the following information must be submitted:

- 3. Academic Advisor's confirmation by signature that this cultural trip will resultin credits toward a degree at Truman.
- 4. Semester, Summer, dates, costs, and credits for the trip.
- 5. The student must be enrolled at Truman State University with a \$600 administrative fee on an approved Truman program for credit in order to receive the Pershing Stipend and for this money to be forwarded to the sponsoring/host institution.
